



Key Terms and Definitions

Registered Student — Parent or Guardian has submitted all forms with payment online. Student is eligible to attend programs, sessions, activities, and events NorthStar and/or Outward Bound offers for current Term 1 year.

Enrolled Student — Parent or Guardian has confirmed Student will be participating in an upcoming programs, sessions, activities, and events NorthStar and/or Outward Bound offers. All Registration Requirements have been met.

Class — A field trip, adventure, outing, class, event, session, or activity that is part of NorthStar and Outward Bound programming.

UserName — The Primary email account associated with the Students Registration Profile. This email is used for communication with the Parent/Guardian of the Student.

Student ID — An identification # generated by NorthStar used for internal and third party entity reporting identification, and other reference information. This # does not change during the course of a Student attending NorthStar or Outward Bound.

Registration Magic — The name of the web based online registration software and process. The student database is stored within, it provides reporting, statistical information, and feeds Track CC students records system.

Track CC — The system that enrolls students in classes and records attendance, grades, behavior, teacher information, student notes and can communicate with Students, Admin, Teachers, Guardians and others via Email, txt message, notes on the student file, preset notifications and alerts. Students, Guardians, and Parents can self set up accounts to monitor the students information.
